Information for Applicants – Parking in our office base at The Forum



Parking information

There is currently no parking facility offered by the CCG for new joiners.

Parking in other locations

General information

- Water Gardens ground floor car park can be used by staff at their own cost (standard public tariff £3.50 per day)
- Gadebridge car park is free and is within a 15 minute walk of The Forum at standard pace. It is open 24/7 and the route to The Forum via Leighton Buzzard road is fully lit at night.
- Old Town High Street this car park has about 70 spaces and is well lit. Tariff £1.60 per day, payable by staff at their own cost. Walk to The Forum is estimated as 12 minutes and it is well lit.

Information about the Water Gardens (see map)

Access: There are 20 steps to ground level. There is no lift.

Opening hours: You can enter the Water Gardens during the day from 6am to 6pm. You can drive out of this car park at any time. Walking time to The Forum: 10 minutes at standard pace (including using staircase).

Information about The Marlowes (see map)

Spaces: Parking will be in general public spaces on Level E or above (no designated spaces for CCG staff).

This is a public car park so availability will depend on demand, but during the week it is only 65%/70% occupied and before 10am it is only 50% occupied.

Access: A lift is available.

Opening hours: Official opening is at 8am though it is often is open slightly earlier at 7.45am. The car park closes at 6.30pm on all days other than Thursdays when closing is at 7.30 pm.


Walking time to The Forum: 14 minutes at a standard pace (including using lifts).

Blue Badge holders

Blue badge holders are able to park in the four spaces allocated in the Undercroft car park at The Forum. This is open from 7am to 10pm.

Cycling

There are cycle racks at The Forum as well as shower facilities on the lower ground floor.
