Preceptorship offers you the opportunity to be supported and directed throughout this transition. We aim to support you so that you feel empowered and confident to deliver the highest possible quality of care to the public. Preceptorship will enable you to:

- ♥ develop your confidence and autonomy
- ♥ work alongside an experienced Preceptor
- ♥ attend a dedicated Preceptorship programme to enable you to acquire and expand your knowledge and skills
- ♥ commence on the pathway towards revalidation
- ♥ develop and strengthen your leadership skills.



The Preceptorship programme includes Action learning sets, Venepuncture and Cannulation training, preparation for IV drug administration, understanding and dealing with difficult situations, fundamental finance within the NHS, Sage & thyme – communication skills workshop, record keeping, staff wellbeing, discharge planning and practice supervisor training.



Our programme supports all newly qualified nurses including our internationally educated nurses, our Capital Nurse workforce and all new registrants. You will be supported throughout this journey and will complete a preceptorship competency framework, which includes reflective accounts from practice to enhance learning and contributes to the NMC revalidation process.
