






A Fine City

- In 2012, Norwich became England's first UNESCO City of Literature, thanks to the city's long literary history: from Julian of Norwich, the first woman to be published in English in the 14th century, to the establishing of the first Creative Writing Masters at UEA, with graduates including Booker Prize Winners Ian McEwan, Anne Enwright and Kazuo Ishiguro.
- From fine dining to Street Food markets Norwich has a thriving food scene with a wide range of independent places to suit everyone's taste buds.
- With large shopping malls and department stores in the city centre it wont be hard to find your favourite shops but don't miss out on the independent boutiques and local institutions to be found in the Norwich Lanes!
