#### ***Essential***

- Experience in working in Gyn Oncology

- Evidence of specialty training at ST6 or higher in Obstetrics and Gynaecology
- Evidence of 3 years clinical experience in obstetrics and gynaecology
- Clear aptitude for gynaecology operating.
