Juniper is also the centralised ward for people being treated with ECT.
- Beech Ward is a 22 bedded mixed adult acute admissions ward for people aged 18-65 offering assessment and treatment to the people in its care.  forensic history. With a combination of beds commissioned locally and

Whichever one of our wards you chose to work on you'll be working in a multidisciplinary team which includes medical staff, Allied Health Professionals (including Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy), a Health and Fitness team and peer support workers/volunteers.
