This is an opportunity to gain experience, a range of new skills and build up a service that is utilising the latest digital innovations and experience of integrated working across Bradford and Airedale acute and community trusts as well as the local authority, health and social care providers and the voluntary sector.

There are a number of roles available to support the implementation of the Virtual Ward which are advertised on NHS Jobs.
