HMP Dovegate is a Category B adult male facility near Uttoxeter, Staffordshire. The prison accommodates up to 1,060 male adult prisoners over the age of 21 serving a range of sentences including trial, remand, those awaiting sentence and convicted men serving long and short-term sentences. The service has a purpose-built therapeutic facility which offers help to offenders stop their pattern of offending.
