We are looking for full time Neuro-Rehabilitation Consultant but we will also consider a job share for an enthusiastic individual dedicated to the delivery of 'great healthcare from great people'.

Role specific duties

EKHUFT has one of the largest Neuroscience centres outside London, we have a vibrant team which contributes towards an exciting team dynamic which incorporates the knowledge of experienced neurologists with the enthusiasm and vitality of a junior doctor team.

A progressive consultant would enrich our approach and contribute towards not only service delivery but would be able to develop concepts that would advance neurosciences within east Kent.

The East Kent Neuro Rehab Unit (EKNRU) is a 19-bed in-patient facility which acts as Level 2B Specialist Neuro-rehab Centre for whole of east Kent. EKNRU is part of a large Neuroscience department with another 18-bed acute Neurology facility. Both these wards are collocated in Kent & Canterbury Hospital. A large and specialist multi-disciplinary team consisting of Principal Neuro-psychologists, Neurological physiotherapists, OTs, Dietetics, Speech therapist & nurses.

The case-mix includes acquired brain injury, complex stroke, Neuropathies, MS, Parkinson's Disease and spinal injuries.

There is a Trust Grade doctor and a Physician Associate attached to the in-patient Unit. The Unit is well known for educational, training and research opportunities. EKNRU regularly organise multi-disciplinary Neuro-rehab conferences. There is a comprehensive research programme with national and international reputation. The postholder will be encouraged to join the academic activities.

There is close co-operation with a large Neurology service. There is a weekly training programme for CMT and STs of Neurology and EKNRU including neuro-radiology meeting which the PA would attend along with Trust Grade doctor. There is immediate access to the neurology STs and Consultants.

There is access to urgent radiology, pathology, Biochemistry and surgical services which are on –site. The patients are referred from Neurology ward, ITU, Stroke Units, Orthopaedics and medical wards of EKHUFT. Often patients are referred from Neuro-surgical facilities of London.

There is excellent liaison with community-based Rehab services (ICT) and charities like Headway, MS Therapy Centre and Kent Brain injury Forum (KBIF).

EKNRU lead the spasticity service including botulinum toxin therapy and assessment for intra-thecal Baclofen pump. The EKNRU offers in-patient, out-patient and follow up for its patients to monitor health needs, promote community reintegration and access the full range of rehabilitation services at the Centre.



The Physician Associate will largely focus on care of inpatients. Elective admissions allow patients with established injury to have intensive therapy to improve their functional independence or have specific medical issues addressed.

The post-holder will lead:

- Care of 19 bedded in-patient facility including up to 2 Tracheostomy patients.
- Lead weekly MDT meeting
- Line manage & supervise Trust Grade Doctor & Physician Associate
- 3 to 4 out-patient clinics per week.
- Lead Spasticity service including injection of Botox, Xeomin and determine eligibility for Intrathecal Baclofen Pump
- Lead the clinical Governance aspects of Neuro-rehab service
- Produce & disseminate Annual Report of service performance based on UKROC Database
- Lead the triage of new referrals to decide admission or sign-posting to allied services in the Community

The post will be appointed to under the Terms and Conditions of Service for Hospital Medical and Dental Staff. You are required to be fully registered with the General Medical Council and on the Specialist Register or eligible for inclusion on the Specialist Register within six months of the date of interview.

You will be required to reside not more than 30 minutes away from your base, unless specific approval is given by the Chief Executive and Chief Medical Officer. You will need to be able to be contacted by the Trust at all times .
