

Foundation Pharmacist Rotations

Cardiology (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

An opportunity to strengthen your knowledge of cardiovascular medicine and surgery whilst ensuring safe and optimum treatment for patients by covering cardiology and cardiothoracic wards, coronary care unit and cardio intensive care unit. An additional opportunity to gain insight into pharmacist led heart failure clinics.

General Surgery (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Gain an insight into a wide variety of surgical procedures including bariatric, colorectal, gynaecological, vascular and ENT whilst strengthening your skills to effectively consult and manage patients peri- and post-operatively.

Acute medicine (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Be an active part of the ward teams covering two fast paced medical admissions wards, short stay unit and rapid access frailty units. Here you will develop safe and effective decision making skills and become a proactive member of the MDT. You will also enhance your skills in history taking, clinical assessments and patient examinations.

Paediatrics (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Experience the role of a paediatric pharmacist, with the opportunity to ensure safe and effective prescribing and dosing of medications for babies, infants and young adults. Experience a range of areas including paediatric medical and surgical wards, paediatric intensive care unit and neonatal unit.

General medicine (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Have the opportunity to spend time on endocrine, elderly care and respiratory wards, and learn how to manage complex conditions including diabetes and COPD. Here there is also opportunity to better understand issues around patient adherence, and how to positively influence this.

Neurology (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Gain an insight into the exciting world of neurology, covering neuro-medicine, neuro-surgery and neuro-rehab wards. You will strengthen your knowledge of parkinsons, epilepsy, multiple sclerosis and other neurological conditions whilst working alongside expert advanced clinical pharmacists within the speciality.

Aseptics and Oncology (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Experience the world of production and manufacturing in a busy aseptics unit where you can utilise and strengthen your skills in calculations and effective dosing. You will also gain a deeper understanding of chemotherapy and managing its side effects by spending time on the oncology inpatient ward.

Trauma, Orthopaedics, and Spinal Rehabilitation (Base: James Cook University Hospital, Middlesbrough)

Strengthen your knowledge of spinal injuries, whilst learning how to pharmaceutically manage patients who have undergone complex traumas. Also gain opportunities to be part of service developments such as pharmacy roles in theatres and in pre-assessment clinics.

Acute and General Medicine (Base: Friarage Hospital, Northallerton)

Have the opportunity to develop your prioritisation and delegation skills whilst working on the clinical decisions unit and medical wards at Friarage hospital, where you will develop and utilise skills to safely and effectively transcribe prescriptions on admission and at discharge.

Mental Health (Base: Roseberry Park Hospital, Middlesbrough)

An exciting opportunity to rotate to our neighbouring mental health trust. Here you will gain an insight into a wide variety of mental health conditions. You will be an active part of the team providing clinical pharmacy services for inpatients including monitoring of blood results to ensure safe and effective treatments.
